# Wheatley Parish Council Community Emergency Plan

## 1. Introduction

Whilst responses to major emergencies are normally co-ordinated by the emergency services, local authorities or other agencies, local councils have an important role to play in sharing local knowledge and supporting the community.

A Community Emergency Plan was initiated by the parish council, but not completed until the end of 2022.

## 2. What is an emergency

Types of emergencies could be:

- Loss of life
- Human illness or injury
- Homelessness
- Damage to property
- Disruption to the supply of money, food water or electricity
- Disruption to communication systems such as telephones and internet, for more than twelve hours.
- Disruption to transport
- Disruption to health services
- Contamination of land, water, or air with biological or chemical matter, or disruption or destruction of animal or plant life
- War or terrorism

Other issues that are more likely to affect the village or residents are:

- Infectious diseases, pandemics
- Major transport incident (e.g., M40/A40)
- Adverse weather/storm damage
- Loss of electricity, gas, or water
- Explosion, major fire, gas leak
- Air accident
- Building collapse

### **3. What to do in an emergency**

If you spot an emergency, please:

- Call 999
- Give them the following information.
- Your name and contact number
- Exact location (address, what3words location)
- Details of incident
- Hazards, roads blocked, access.
- Estimated casualties.
- Emergency services requested.

### **4. Commencement of Emergency Plan**

The commencement of an emergency plan will be at the discretion of Oxfordshire County Council's Emergency Planning team.

However, the parish council may choose to implement elements of the plan at other times.

### **5. Wheatley Community**

Wheatley is a very active and supportive community, with many facilities, groups, organisations, and volunteers. The covid 19 pandemic and other recent events, have highlighted how the community can work together and support each other.

Wheatley is made up of a mix of all ages but does have an aged population. Aware of the restrictions of GDPR(UK) the council does not hold a list of vulnerable persons, but it does actively encourage vulnerable residents to register as priority users and it supports the work of village-based voluntary groups.

## 6. Wheatley Community Emergency Plan

This plan is split into three sections:

- Section 1 – to be shared with OCC Emergency Response Team
- Section 2 – to be used for non- major situations and will be used to support the parish, community, and residents. Contacts available via [Wheatley Directory](#)
- Section 3 – confidential details of local volunteers, skills, and equipment. Access will be limited to the Chairman and Vice Chairman of Wheatley Parish Council as well as the Clerk and Assistant Clerk.
