Our [website](#) is run by Wheatley Parish Council and hosted externally. In line with Public Sector Bodies (Website and Mobile Applications) Accessibility Regulations 2018 the council wants the site to be accessible to as many people as possible. For example, you should be able to:

- Change colours and fonts
- Zoom in upto 300% without text spilling off the screen
- Navigate most of the website using a keyboard
- Navigate most of the website using speech recognition software
- Listen to most of the website using a screen reader
