CHAIRMAN'S COLUMN Geoff Stephens

The newly-elected Parish Council is now in place and has already started taking decisions on your behalf. Over the next four year term important decisions will be made affecting most residents of Wheatley either directly or indirectly. These will include regular issues such as parking, planning considerations, village infrastructure, traffic, etc., but looming large on the horizon is the question of the adoption of a Neighbourhood Plan. We have already decided to take the first steps in this direction and will shortly be consulting more widely in the village for your views and to identify individuals that might want to participate in the process.

A critical factor will be the channels through which residents and the Parish Council communicate with each other. In addition to the established channels (this newsletter, Parish website, noticeboards, open forums at meetings, etc.), we will shortly be adopting social media as an efficient and timely way of sending out notifications of meetings, agendas and minutes.

We know that whilst most residents are internet-savvy, we are well aware there is a significant minority who are not, or do not have the necessary equipment. However, the village library is an excellent resource through which this information can be accessed and there are is very capable team of friendly volunteers who are only too happy to help.

The coming months are likely to be very busy with major issues and it will be more important than ever for us all to stay fully informed.

CLERK'S COLUMN Gareth Morris

At its last meeting the Parish Council accepted, with regret, the resignation of Councillor Joyce Coveley. Councillor Coveley was first co-opted on to the Parish Council in 1999 and has served ever since. She became a stalwart of the Planning Committee and her expertise and knowledge will be greatly missed. The Parish Council wishes to place on record their gratitude to Councillor Coveley for her support and hard work for the council during her sixteen year tenure.

As a result, a vacancy on the council was declared and the Returning Officer at South Oxfordshire informed. Notices were posted saying that there was a vacancy on the Parish Council. If 10 electors, within 10 days of the notice (not including Saturdays and Sundays), wrote to the Returning Officer claiming an election then SODC would organise one (at the Parish's expense). If an election wasn't claimed then the Parish Council could co-opt at its meeting in September. At the time of writing it is not known if an election has been claimed. I will post details on the website and the notice boards as soon as I know.

Also at its last meeting the Parish Council recommended approval to SODC of the development of 51 dwellings, with access from London Road, together with associated landscaping and open space provision. This will be a 'rural exception site' made up of 38 affordable/joint ownership properties and 13 open market properties. If you wish to be considered for a property then you need to be registered with SODC Housing Department.

Hopefully, by now, you will have received your new Wheatley Information Booklet. If you have not received a copy please contact the Parish Office and arrange to pick a copy up. Many thanks to Doug Lamont and Tim Blightman for putting the booklet together and to the Parish Councillors and the Assistant Clerk for delivering them.

We've moved. South Oxfordshire District Council (SODC) has now moved into their new, temporary, offices on Milton Park near Abingdon following the devastating fire earlier in the year. I do understand that if you're planning to visit it's a bit far away, but most services can be accessed via the website at www.southoxon.gov.uk Further information can be found in the Outlook magazine you should have recently received.

Do you want to have a say over if or where new homes, shops or offices are built within our village or what new buildings should look like? Maybe you want to protect and enhance our high street or protect our local green spaces for generations to enjoy in years to come?

As part of my election campaign, I said that I supported the creation of a neighbourhood plan and I'm continuing to push this. A neighbourhood plan is a community-led framework for guiding the future development and growth of an area. Some of the benefits include providing local people and businesses influence over their future and gives communities a say over where development should happen and what it should look like. It also allows us to protect and enhance our historic and natural environment whilst also identifying and addressing local traffic and transport issues.

I'll be working with the local parish councils to help them decide if this is something we should undertake and I'd welcome you contacting me with your views or for further information.

Finally, school summer holidays are now underway so when you're driving, please look out for our children and young adults as I'm sure many will be outside taking advantage of our sports and recreation facilities and cycling or walking around the village. OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL Anne Purse, County Councillor

The better weather has not brought us a respite from potholes. Although many have been filled, there is still need for further work as I write. If anyone sees a pothole the best thing to do is to report it straight away on **Fix My Street** on the County Council's website (www.oxfordshire.gov.uk). If, after reporting, it is still not getting fixed, please do get in touch with me and I can follow it up. If I am told about a pothole before it has been reported, unless it is far bigger or more dangerous than usual, the first thing I have to do is come out to look at it to see the exact place, so that I can then put it onto Fix My Street. Unfortunately there is not a Councillor's 'short cut' to get most unreported potholes done, but I am always happy to chase up once they have been reported.

You may have heard that there is to be a consultation on the County's refuse recycling centres, with a hint that some may close. The problem as I see it is that it must be made fairly easy for people to do the right thing with their waste to avoid our countryside being blighted by fly-tipping, Recycling centres have a vital role to play in this.

Less money coming to County Councils and subsequent cut backs caused by this are also putting Children's Centres such as the Maple Tree Children's Centre in Wheatley under heavy strain. If anyone has a child who goes there or has any other connection with the Centre and wants to discuss this, I would be very pleased to speak with them. I am pledging my support both to the Children's Centres and to rural buses (also being consulted on now) at this time of cuts to services. What is becoming clear is that the rural population is going to be particularly hard hit by some of the proposed changes in the future.

THE HISTORY FILE - French Connection Wheatley John Fox

The Normans transformed England, Ireland and Wales, just like their 'Norsemen' ancestors made northern France 'Normandy'. France and England merged. Upper and Lower Chilworth hamlets (now lost) between Gt Milton-Tiddington – Wheatley, became Upper Chilworth *St Valery* for its abbey landowner on the Somme, and Lower Chilworth *Musard* for its new family lords on the Seine. The de Brays (of Pays de Bray) and de Cursons (of Courcon), held Waterperry; the bishop of Bayeux held Forest Hill, while the d'Oillys of Falaise (*Doyley Farm*, Stadhampton road) were the governors of Oxford and Wallingford. When the de Louches (of Calais) who owned Great Milton and Wheatley, married into an old Norfolk/Sussex family of de Camoys, Gt Milton manor house became 'Camoys Court' [today's *Le Manoir*] and Wheatley became 'Wheatley *Camoys*'. Thomas, Baron Camoys (lord of many English manors), was a general officer commanding at Agincourt (1415). The victory allowed Henry V to inherit the French throne, but he failed to occupy it.

A solitary other Wheatley link can be established from the 'Hundred Years War' with France: John Marshal went AWOL in 1384 with all his kit. Agincourt was a 'bubble', France revived and burst it, Joan of Arc inspired everyone and England's French Connection collapsed. Roger Camoys, younger son of Baron Camoys of Wheatley, surrendered Bordeaux in 1453. England kept Calais for another century and still holds most of Les *Isles Anglo-Normandes* [Channel Islands]. In 1801, late but realistic, Britain finally dropped the irises ('lilies') 'of France from its Royal Arms.

If so, the idea of a Wheatley Garden Share scheme is for you! We want to match owners and growers.

The Wheatley Village Archives are stored on the first floor of the Merry Bells and the room is open on Thursday afternoons between 2pm and 5pm (other times by arrangement). The volunteers answer enquiries by email and help visitors to pursue their research.

The Archive room houses details of past Wheatley residents, houses, churches, roads, hostelries, family trees, photos, artefacts, diaries, journals and old maps of Wheatley and the surrounding area.

Over the last few weeks we have helped a visitor research the involvement of women from Cuddesdon in WW1. Six visitors from Yorkshire and two from Somerset came to research their connections to local families. RESEARCH STUDY - calls for local people with early Parkinson's to help find a cure, Corrina Purdue

Every hour, someone in the UK is told they have Parkinson's, a degenerative neurological condition, for which there is currently no cure. The main symptoms of the condition are tremor, slowness of movement and rigidity. Parkinson's affects 127,000 people in the UK - which is around one in 500 of the population.

Parkinson's UK is the leading national charity supporting people with the condition. To complete the first phase of its ground-breaking Monument Discovery Project, local people with early Parkinson's are needed to volunteer for a series of tests at their hospital. Diagnosing Parkinson's before the movement symptoms appear, combined with more effective treatments that can slow or stop the condition's progress, will be crucial steps towards a cure.

Researchers at the **Oxford Parkinson's Disease Centre (OPDC)** are inviting people diagnosed with Parkinson's in the last 3 years to help them understand the earliest signs of the condition.

Participants are invited to attend research clinics at their local hospital. Taking part would involve a simple blood test and a range of assessments of sense of smell, thinking, memory and mobility. Participants are followed up in clinic every 18 months until 2020.




